

# Privacy policy

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## 1. Purpose of the regulations

The purpose of these Regulations is to record Nomad Jewelry LTD. (Company Number 14447323) data protection and data management principles and the Company's data protection and data management policy.

## 2. Name of the data controller

A <https://nomadjewelry.eu> website (hereinafter: website) by Nomad Jewelry LTD. (hereinafter: entrepreneur) is operated.

The entrepreneur is the data manager of all personal data that users provide voluntarily on the website by filling out the contact form.

In point 7 of this information, the entrepreneur also fulfills the obligation to inform visitors of the website and browsers about cookies.

The entrepreneur is a data controller who determines the purpose of data management, makes decisions regarding data management and performs operations or a set of operations on the data, as well as prevents the further use of the data.

The entrepreneur only handles personal data that has been previously and voluntarily given by those who are interested in the services provided by the entrepreneur and applicants.

In court or official proceedings initiated at the request of the user, the consent of the person concerned must be assumed with regard to the personal data provided by the user, which is necessary for the conduct of the procedure, and in other cases initiated at the request of the user.

The entrepreneur is committed to the protection of users' personal data, and considers it of utmost importance to respect the users' right to self-determination of information. The entrepreneur treats personal data confidentially and takes all security, technical and organizational measures that guarantee the security of the data.

The entrepreneur, as a data controller, declares that he recognizes the content of this data management information sheet as binding for him, and declares that all data management related to his activities meets the requirements set out in these regulations and the applicable legislation. ## **4. Scope of personal data handled, method of data management**

### **4.1. Browse our website**

Simple browsing of the website <https://nomadjewelry.eu> does not require registration, in this case we do not record or store any personal data about our visitors.

### **4.2. Data entry on the contact page**

The user can write a letter to the entrepreneur on the Contact page. In this case, the name, e-mail address, the subject of the inquiry and the content of the message are among the data entered when filling out the form. The data provided here is sufficient for contact, the data is stored only until the e-mail is processed and a response is provided. The establishment of a specific business is not related to the services of the website, there is no registration. It is mandatory to fill in (tick) the "Accept" (checkbox) field on the form! Acceptance means that the customer has read the contents of this detailed Data Management Information and accepts what is written in it. The user must initiate the possible deletion of the data provided during the filling out of the form by contacting one of the contractor's contacts (info@nomadjewelry.eu, +36-20-507-6682.).

### **4.3. Other restrictions**

The entrepreneur declares that he will not request special data from the user under any circumstances and will not keep records.

The data management of the entrepreneur's activities is based on voluntary consent. In some cases, however, the management and transmission of a range of the provided data is made mandatory by law, of which the entrepreneur will notify the user separately.

## **5. Basic concepts related to data protection**

GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation) is the new Data Protection Regulation of the European Union;

***data subject:*** any natural person identified or - directly or indirectly - identified on the basis of personal data;

***personal data:*** data that can be linked to the data subject (any information about an identified or identifiable natural person) - in particular the data subject's name, identification number, number, location data, online identifier, as well as one or more of the natural person's physical, physiological, genetic, mental, knowledge specific to his mental, economic, cultural or social identity - as well as the conclusion that can be drawn from the data regarding the data subject;

***consent:*** the voluntary, clear and decisive declaration of the data subject's will, which is based on specific and appropriate information, and with which he gives his unequivocal consent to the processing of his personal data - in full or covering certain operations;

***protest:*** the statement of the data subject objecting to the handling of his personal data and requesting the termination of the data processing or the deletion of the processed data;

***data controller:*** the natural or legal person, public authority, agency or organization without legal personality, or any other body that determines the purposes and means of personal data management independently or together with others, makes decisions regarding data management (including the device used) and executes it or has it executed by the data processor. The data controller or special aspects regarding the designation of the data controller may also be determined by EU or member state law;

***data management:*** regardless of the procedure used, any operation performed on the data or the set of operations, in particular the collection, recording, recording, organization, segmentation, storage, transformation or change, query, insight into its content, use, communication, transmission, disclosure , align or connect, limit, block, delete and destroy, as well as prevent the further use of the data;

***data transfer:*** making the data available to a specific third party;

***disclosure:*** making the data available to anyone;

***data deletion:*** making data unrecognizable in such a way that their recovery is no longer possible;

***data designation:*** providing the data with an identification mark for the purpose of distinguishing it;

***data blocking:*** providing the data with an identification mark for the purpose of limiting its further processing permanently or for a specified period of time;

***data destruction:*** complete physical destruction of the data carrier containing the data;

***data processing:*** performing technical tasks related to data management operations, regardless of the method and tool used to perform the operations, as well as the place of application, provided that the technical task is performed on the data;

***data processor:*** a natural or legal person, or an unincorporated organization, public authority, agency, or any other body which, on the basis of a contract - including a contract concluded under the provisions of the law - manages personal data and processes data on behalf of the data controller ;

***data controller:*** the body performing a public task, which produced data of public interest that must be published electronically, or whose operation generated this data;

***data provider:*** the body performing a public task, which - if the data controller does not publish the data himself - publishes the data provided by the data controller on the website;

***data file:*** the totality of the data managed in one register;

***recipient:*** the natural or legal person, public authority, agency or any other body to whom the personal data is communicated, regardless of whether it is a third party. Public authorities that

have access to personal data in accordance with EU or Member State law in the context of an individual investigation are not considered recipients; the management of said data by these public authorities must comply with the applicable data protection rules in accordance with the purposes of data management;

**third party:** the natural or legal person, public authority, agency or any other body that is not the same as the data subject, the data controller, the data processor or the persons who have been authorized to handle personal data under the direct control of the data controller or data processor.

**data protection incident:** unlawful handling or processing of personal data, including in particular unauthorized access, disclosure, loss, alteration, transmission, disclosure, deletion or destruction, as well as accidental or unlawful destruction and damage.

## 6. General information about Data Protection

Personal data can be processed if

- a) the person concerned consents to it, or
- b) it is ordered by law or - on the basis of its legal authority, within the scope defined therein - by a local government decree for a purpose based on public interest (mandatory data management).

Personal data may be processed even if obtaining the data subject's consent would be impossible or disproportionately expensive, and the processing of personal data is necessary for the purpose of fulfilling a legal obligation to the data controller, or is necessary for the purpose of asserting the legitimate interest of the data controller or a third party, and the enforcement of this interest is based on the personal data is proportionate to the limitation of the right to protection.

The consent of the legal representative is required for the declaration of an incapacitated person and a minor with limited legal capacity under the age of 16, except for those parts of the service where the declaration is aimed at data processing that occurs en masse in everyday life and does not require special consideration.

If the data subject is unable to give his consent due to his incapacity or other unavoidable reasons, then to the extent necessary to protect his own or another person's vital interests, as well as to eliminate or prevent a direct threat to the life, physical integrity or property of the persons concerned, the data subject's personal data will be processed as long as there are obstacles to consent they are manageable.

If the personal data was recorded with the consent of the data subject, the data controller shall, unless otherwise provided by law, process the recorded data

- a) for the purpose of fulfilling the legal obligation relating to it, or

b) for the purpose of asserting the legitimate interests of the data controller or a third party, if the assertion of this interest is proportional to the limitation of the right to the protection of personal data without further separate consent, and may be processed even after the consent of the data subject has been revoked.

Data processing may only take place to the extent and for the duration necessary to achieve the purpose.

## **7. Rules for the use of cookies**

### **7.1. What are cookies and what does Nomad Jewelry use them for?**

When visiting the nomadjewelry.eu website, the user downloads one or more cookies - i.e. a small information package containing a string of characters - to his computer, through which his browser can be uniquely identified.

By accepting the information displayed at the bottom of the screen, the visitor consents to the use of Nomad Jewelry's cookies described in this policy. During subsequent visits, the warning text will not appear on the screen, however, the possibility of removing cookies always exists, the user can do this in the settings of his browser.

If the visitor decides to ignore the notification and continue using the website, a cookie will be placed on the computer that records this choice and the further use of the website will be considered as approval of the use of cookies used on that website.

Please note that the functions of the nomadjewelry.eu website are only valid if you disable the use of cookies. The help of the Internet browser provides assistance in managing the settings related to cookies.

Nomad Jewelry is not responsible for the content of other external websites that may use cookies.

### **7.2 Types of cookies used on the nomadjewelry.eu website:**

The cookies used by Nomad Jewelry can be classified into the following categories:

- tracking cookies
- web beacon cookies
- functional cookies
- statistical cookies

*Tracking cookies*

Tracking cookies are connected to services provided by third parties, such as measuring the effectiveness of Google and Facebook advertisements, etc. The third party provides these services in exchange for being informed that you have visited our website. We may also use cookies to connect to social networks (such as Facebook), which may later use information about your visit for personalized advertising on other websites.

#### *Web beacon cookies*

Web beacons are small, invisible images that we use in our email newsletter. With their application, we can obtain statistical information about the use of newsletters and help to improve them. If you want to prevent the collection of statistical data, disable the use of HTML in your mail system.

#### *Functional cookies*

Functional cookies are used to provide services, to record settings and fill out forms, thereby improving the experience provided by the visit and the website. Functional cookies cannot be used to send you advertisements on other websites.

#### *Statistical cookies*

Statistical cookies collect information about the use of the website, for example, which pages the user visits and what errors occur. The operation of these cookies is completely anonymous and they only contribute to improving the functioning of the website and help to understand the interests of users. Statistical cookies only provide statistical data about the use of the website and help to improve the website by assessing the errors that occur. Cookies classified as statistics do not collect information that could be used for personalized advertising of products and services on other websites.

## **8. Duration of data management**

In the case of data entered on the contact page, data management lasts from the time the data is entered until the data in question is used (response e-mail) and then until it is deleted.

The above provisions do not affect the fulfillment of retention obligations defined in legislation (e.g. accounting legislation), as well as data processing based on additional consents given in other ways on the website.

## **9. Other provisions**

We use the above-mentioned data exclusively for the purpose for which our user provided it, and in no case will we pass it on to third parties, with the exception of the authorities - court,

prosecutor's office, investigative authority, infringement authority, public administrative authority, National Data Protection and Information Authority or legislation on the basis of its authorization, other authorities - to which we are obliged to release the data by indicating the exact purpose and the scope of the data.

The user's data is stored by the entrepreneur in the storage space rented from the service provider named in point 3 of this document.

**range of processed data:** e-mail address, name, subject, message text.

**Scope of data processing:** The contractor and the user for the duration of the contact.

The purpose of data processing: Establishing contact between the user and the entrepreneur, conducting communication in connection with the use of the service provided by the entrepreneur.

The legal basis for data processing: the user's consent, which is given by filling in the regularized form for data entry (CXII of 2011, § 5 (1) para. a)

Duration of data processing: lasts until the purpose of data management is achieved.

## **10. Data security**

The requirement for the enforcement of data security is Info tv. one of the essential principles, the enforcement of which the entrepreneur keeps in mind above all. The contractor protects the data against unauthorized access, alteration, disclosure, damage and destruction with reasonable measures in accordance with the current state of the art.

The contractor will not release the user's recorded data to third parties without authorization. the contractor implements the mandatory regulations contained in the law by protecting the confidentiality, integrity and availability of the data in an organizational (humane, legal) and technical (physical, logical) way.
